PVL Budget Planning

It's that time of year when we start planning our budget for next year. As always, we have a few suggestions from members, so we'd like to get some feedback on these items as well as solicit any additional ideas you may have. The ideas we have so far include the following:



Addition of sail shades at the pool. Those of you that use the pool know that there is no shade whatsoever at the pool until very late in the day. One suggestion is to add some sail shades (triangular weather proof cloth) to provide shade over parts of the pool deck area.



Addition of a pavilion near the beach. We've noticed a significant increase in the number of families that use the beach on the weekends in the summer so there's been a suggestion to add a concrete pad, a cover, and some additional picnic tables.

Widening the road on the west side of the lodge to allow more parking. This suggestion would add about 20 parking spots. The diagram below shows roughly what it may look like, except we would be doing diagonal parking instead of straight in.



Extension of RV parking pads and additional electricity upgrades in Campground. This continues some of the work we started last year to adding water spigots and upgrading electricity to 50-amp service at more sites, plus extending the length of pads to accommodate today's larger RVs.

The costs for the sail shades will probably run between \$500 and \$1000 to acquire and install. The pavilion would be in the \$5000-7500 range, and the additional parking would be in the \$5000 to \$10,000 range. Campground upgrades are estimated in the \$5000 range. 
meal, some caroling, and in general just sharing the joy of the holiday season!!

Gasconade County PWSD # 1 Wastewater Treatment Upgrade (Lagoon Project) Work Plan and Schedule (as of 11/7/18)

Winter 2018/2019:

- Submit first draft of the Facility Plan (FP) to the Missouri Department of Natural Resources (DNR). This will include the evaluation of several treatment options, and first/best choice of the PWSD. As with the Water Study, there will be discussions/review with the DNR prior to their approval.
- Continue with select collection system repairs (focus on worst condition based on CCTV inspection, as well as Inflow & Infiltration (I&I) reduction.
- Continue Flow Observations during rain events

Summer 2019 to Summer 2020: **

- Pursue funding options (loans and grants)
- Acquire ground needed for Lagoon Project (LP) and long-term improvements
- Continue select collection system repairs, with primary focus on worst condition and imminent failure.

Fall 2020-Spring 2021:......Design plans, specifications, and contract documents

Spring 2021:Submit to DNR for approval and issuance of construction permit

Summer 2021: Solicit bids for construction

Fall 2021 -Fall 2022......Construction and transition from current single cell lagoon treatment to the new

December 31, 2022:Project complete

** If State Revolving Funding (SRF) is pursued, add another year to this step, and push remaining dates out a year, with final project completion by December 31, 2023

Restaurant Review: Meramec Vineyard & Winery, St. James, MO

The Meramec Vineyards & Winery at 600 Rt. B in St. James has been around since 1999, but as of January 2018 has a new set of owners, Joe and Michelle Boulware. Joe and Michelle and their two small children have a vision of a family-friendly venue with food to go along with the wine. As they make renovations inside and out, they've rolled out a bistro-themed menu, with locally sourced ingredients for a true taste adventure only a few miles from Peaceful Valley. They've got a two-part menu, one with year-round selections featuring appetizers, salads, burgers & sandwiches, and galettes (French-inspired cuisine, similar to a pizza on pastry dough). Their other menu changes with the seasons and features dishes, salads, and a weekly soup special using the season's best ingredients.

Ricky and I went there recently and ordered their Big Prairie Pimiento Dip for an appetizer and a Mushroom, Thyme, and Bacon Galette, which came with a choice of salad. We got the Harvest Apple Thyme Salad from the seasonal menu. The dip was wonderful—pimiento cheese covered with bacon, then baked and topped with green onions, served with freshly baked, toasted French bread slices. We probably could have stopped there. Next came the salad—slices of sweet green apple topping a combination of lettuce (not Romaine anymore) craisins, candied walnuts, parmesan cheese shreds, with an apple thyme vinaigrette dressing. Last came the galette—we had the lunch size portion, which looked like a half of a 10" pizza, with a very light and flaky pastry dough as the base,

covered with a goat cheese/cream cheese mixture then topped with mushrooms and bacon then baked to a toasty brown. Very tasty.

Meramec Vineyards & Winery offers several varieties of private label wine, multiple Missouri craft beer brands on tap, private label hard liquor, and a variety of sangrias featuring different fruit flavors. They're not making their own wine just yet—that's something they're planning. The restaurant is open from 11 AM to 9 PM daily, with a daily lunch special until 3 PM. Every Sunday they host a Food & Family meal featuring a food special along with family friendly games and events, and the occasional musician. From Peaceful Valley, take MO 28 west to Hwy B (right before Bland). South on Hwy B about 21.5 miles, it'll be on your left shortly after you enter the St. James city limits.
