January 28th Trivia Night





Nearby Restaurant Reviews: Dave's Pizza and Wings, and Chop House Grille in Linn, MO

Dave's Pizza and Wings and Chop House Grille are located next door to each other in the same small strip mall just east of Linn off of Highway 50 at 63 Progress Ln, Linn, MO 65051. **Dave's Pizza and Wings** is a sports-themed restaurant that offers, surprise!!, pizza and wings. They serve "St. Louis-

style pizza" using provel cheese, similar to Imo's pizza in St. Louis. They have a vareity of wing sauces ranging from mild to

rating.



The Chop House Grille, located right next to Dave's, is a slightly more upscale restaurant specializing in burgers, sandwiches, and steaks, along with the usual appetizers. The have a small

family friendly, they offer a great special of a two

topping pizza, a bunch of wings for right around

\$20. Dave's Pizza and Wings gets a

salad bar that you can add as a side for an upcharge. It contains all the right items for a great side salad to accompany a dinner or lunch. The place is very bright, spacious and airy, which is unusual as most similar restaurants usually dim their lights to improve their "ambience" and cram tables tightly

together. The food is very good. The last time we went there we got the Chop House Grilled Salad and Emily's BLT. The



Grilled Salad comes with your choice of grilled salmon or chicken breast (grilled or crispy) The Emily's BLT is really special—they use their own creation--"chicken fried bacon"--which is breaded and deep fried. I know it sounds like a real heart stopper, but it comes out amazingly light tasting and crispy. They serve it with their home made "Chop House Sauce" which has unique flavor—it's hard to describe, but it's kind of like a mixture of a BBO sauce and aoli, but on the sweet side. This was perhaps the best BLT I've ever had. My wife liked the sauce so much she got some for her salad. They're open 11-8 Tuesday-Friday, and run a breakfast buffet on Saturday from 8 AM-Noon. <u>کو کے کے کے</u> Chop House gets rating
